How it works

A first-version guide to signing in, moving through the app, joining conversations, learning, and opening the wider WATA ecosystem.

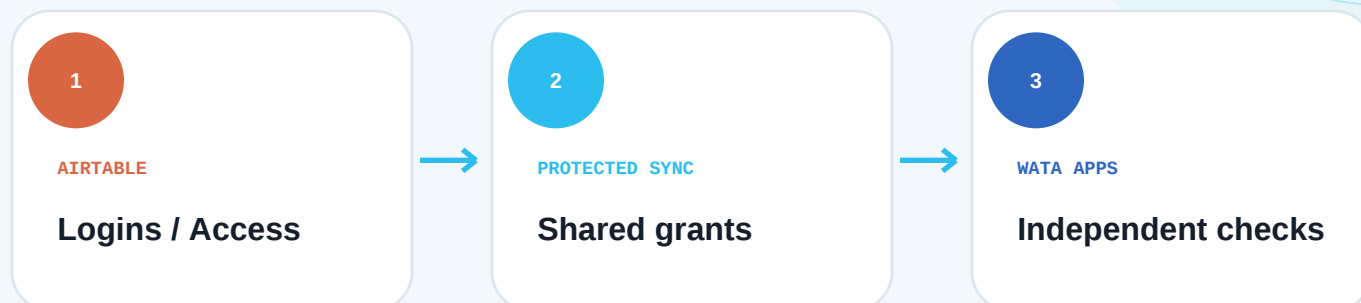

This is not the final manual

It documents the current build so the team can review the experience. Update it only after the app reaches its approved final version.

One ecosystem, one access source

Airtable is the administrative source for who may open each WATA app. Each app still enforces access at its own door.



Why not connect the PWA directly to Airtable?

A direct connection would expose an Airtable credential in a public browser app. The protected sync lets Airtable stay your control panel while the shared identity service safely distributes grants.

- **Sign in with Google**

Use the Google account listed in W.A.T.A.'s Logins / Access table. No SMS provider is required.

- **Identity is shared**

The same person record can be recognized by Community, Tech Hub, Field App, Partner Portal, and Project Hub.

- **Access is scoped**

A role may open an app only for the programs, partners, projects, or spaces listed in the access source.

- **Toolkit reflects real grants**

Tiles appear from your current access record; there is no preview-as-role switcher.

- **Each app checks again**

Hiding a tile is useful navigation, but typing an app URL cannot bypass its own permission check.

- **WATADEX stays open**

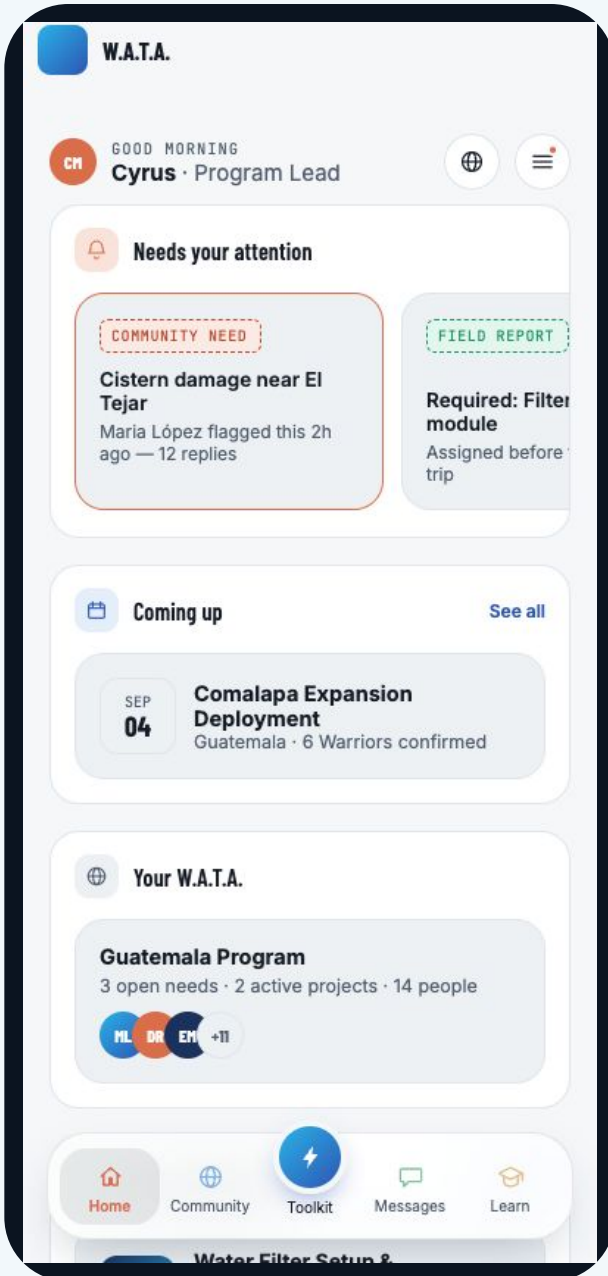
WATADEX remains available without login. SLR and Salty are outside this ecosystem.

Community visibility is separate

An ecosystem role does not automatically decide which feeds or spaces a person sees. Community spaces and memberships control that access.

Start at Home

Home is a personal briefing. It brings urgent items, upcoming events, assigned spaces, learning, and recent Community activity together.

From the community

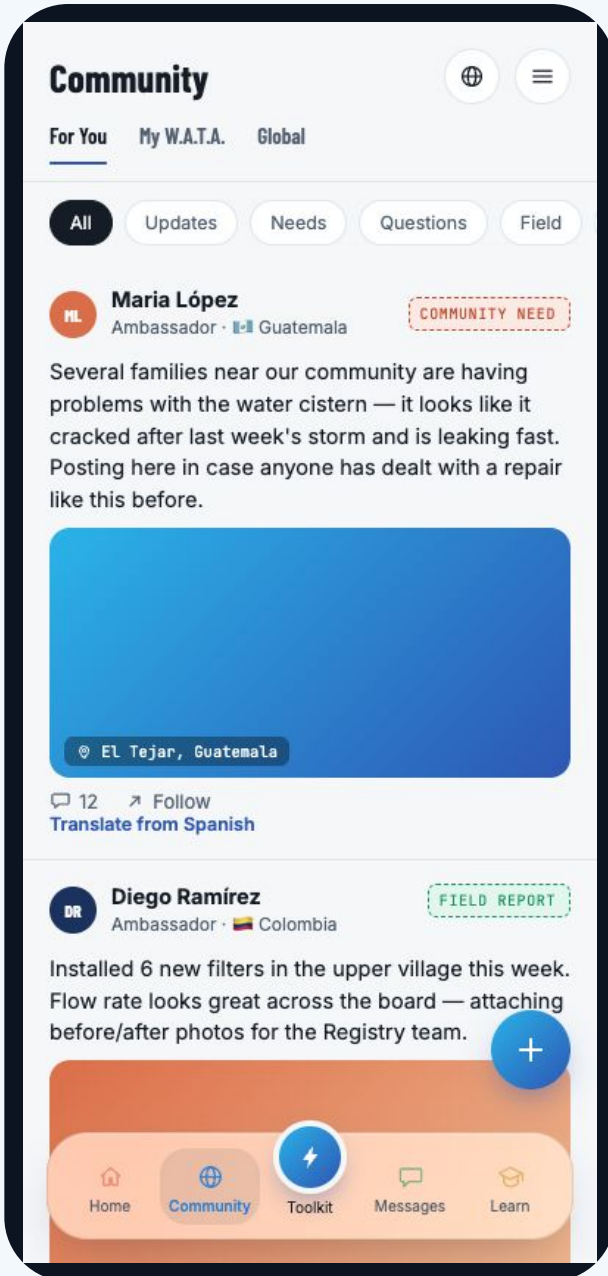
A short preview of posts you are allowed to read.

Mobile and desktop

On phones, navigation floats above the home indicator. At 900 px and wider, it becomes a left sidebar with a right-hand summary rail.

Read, share, and discuss

Community content stays in its original language and appears only when the viewer is allowed into the related space.

- **Choose a feed**

For You combines visible spaces. My W.A.T.A. emphasizes primary memberships. Global shows approved global spaces.

- **Filter by post type**

Updates, Community Needs, Questions, Field Reports, Stories, Resources, and Announcements keep the feed scannable.

- **Open a discussion**

Tap a post to read its replies and follow the conversation.

- **Create a post**

Choose a type, write the update, select an approved space, and record the original language.

Translation

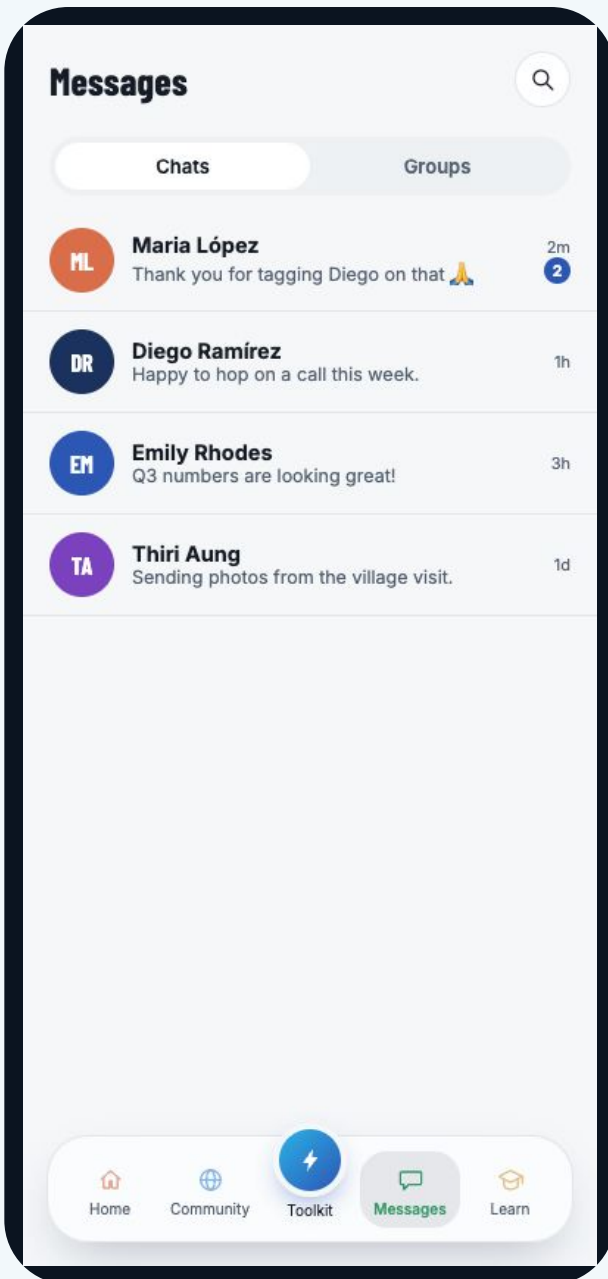
The current version shows a Translate control for posts in another language, but automatic translation is not active yet.

Current attachment status

Media and location data are part of the planned post shape. Upload storage is not yet enabled in this working version.

Messages and offline sending

Messages include direct chats and groups. The current offline behavior is intentionally lighter than the Field App.

1 Write

Compose the message normally.

2 Queue

If offline, it is stored on this device and marked Waiting to send.

3 Reconnect

The app retries with a unique client ID so one message is not sent twice.

4 Confirm

The waiting label disappears after the server accepts it.

What offline mode does not promise

It is not a full field-grade offline database. Cached content may be stale, and new server data appears after connectivity returns.

Learn, connect, and open the Toolkit

The app combines community coordination with learning and a role-aware doorway into the rest of WATA Wonderful World.



Learn

Continue assigned courses and complete ordered lessons.



People

Find visible people by skill, interest, country, or how they can help.

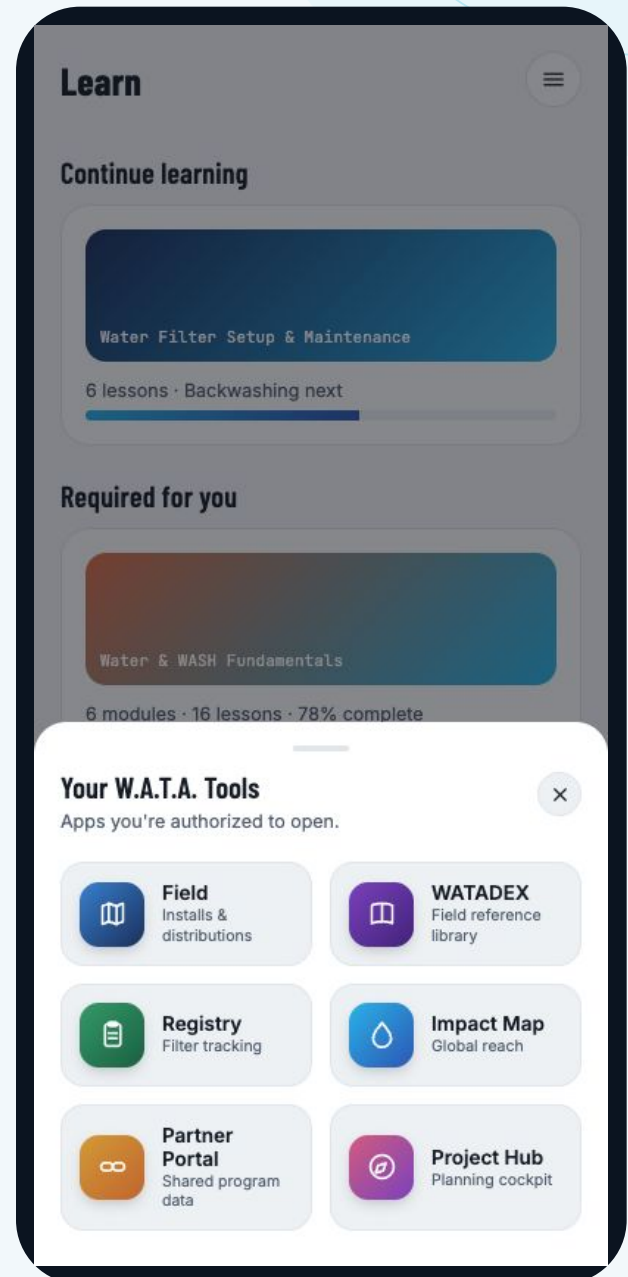


Events

See upcoming events from spaces you may read.

Toolkit is a launcher, not the only lock

Tiles reflect individual app checkboxes. The destination app validates its own grant again.

The menu holds your profile, display choices, language, notifications, people, events, and downloadable guides.

Profile

Name, country, skills, interests, and I can help with.

Appearance

System, W.A.T.A. Light, Dark, Blue, Cyan, or Pink.

3

Language

English or Spanish interface strings. Post content does not change.

4

Notifications

Message, Community, and event preferences in this working version.

5

Guides

Download this full guide, the quick PDF, or the quick PNG.

Working version rule

Use these guides to review version 0.1. Do not keep revising them during every small app change. Rebuild them after the final experience and permissions are approved.
